

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

School bus transportation will be provided for all vocational and governor school students. All students will be required by school board policy to ride the bus to and from the vocational/governor school. Students may drive an automobile with the permission of the principals involved under exceptional conditions as approved by the principals. Neither the school board nor any of its employees will assume responsibility for drivers or passengers riding in private vehicles.

Removal of a student from a regular bus route normally means removal from all buses in the transportation system. Special bus transportation, such as the Botetourt Technical Education Center, the Jackson River Governor's School and the Roanoke Valley Governor's School student transferal during the day, field trips, athletic activity bus and others, may be permitted at the discretion of the administrator when dealing with behavior problems on regular routes.

The following regulations shall be observed in the use of school buses for school sponsored and regularly scheduled activities:

1. Adequate supervision must be provided on each bus.
2. The bus shall be operated by an approved school bus driver.
3. Transportation shall be provided only for students, faculty members, and others having some official connection with the activity.
